1. Declarations of Interest

2. Treuddyn Cemetery

A site meeting was held with Mr Richard Blake during August, to look at improving the waste basket area.

Grass seeding the banks under the yew trees is not ideal growing conditions. Also, around the water tap area becomes slippy during wet weather especially wintertime. Mr Blake has no objection to TCC carrying out work to improve the above.

It was suggested to lay woodchip on the banks and slab around the tap area.

Cllrs. C. Swan & E. Morgan have kindly offered to do the work.
