This is a lovely walk through fields with rich hedgerows full of birds and leafy lanes with pretty banks of wildflowers. The woodland above Scotland Farm has some fabulous old birch trees covered with polypore fungi and an impressive display of foxgloves in the summer.


Look out for a dipper as you cross the ford, while over in the fields you may hear the cry of a buzzard overhead.

## Start in Village Community Centre car park on Queen Street


1 Walk up the path by the side of the Community Centre to the road.

- 2 Turn left onto the road and then right onto the footpath at the side of Ebeneser Chapel. Follow the path around the edge of the field to the stile in the corner diagonally opposite. Go over the stile and carry on along the field edge to the next stile. Go over the stile, turn right and follow the path along the hedgerow to the next stile. Go over this and then go diagonally across the field to the stile by the road.
- 3 Cross over the road and go over the stile opposite. Walk along the field edge, go over the stile and then bear left slightly across the field to the stile in the hedgerow. Go over this and then down the field to the stile by the road.
- 4 Cross over and walk up the field edge to the stile. Go over this and turn left. Follow the path around to the left and go over the stile by the gate onto the road.



**3** Turn left and walk down the lovely old lane with interesting trees and lots of birdsong. Go over the ford and up the hill.
