#### 11. MONTHLY ACTION PLAN

#### 12. NERCWYS ROAD

Travelling over the Terrig Bridge towards Mold.

To discuss inadequate signage warning motorists of the 'Blind Brow', over the last couple of months there has been a number of accidents.

Cllr. K. Cracknell was invited by the Chair to speak on the issue.

Cllr. Cracknell commented, "Nercwys C.C wanted the road speed dropped to 40mph but this is not going to happen. When travelling approximately 100mtrs past Terrig Farm towards Mold the road is a mess, potholes, uneven surface and flooding.

The road has been resurfaced further along but work hasn't commenced on this particular section. Nercwys C.C fully supports anything that can done to improve road safety along this stretch".

Treuddyn residents use this road as the main route to Mold and can be very busy. Travelling down the Terrig Hill, the road narrows over the bridge, there is a 'Blind Brow' just before the Junction of Ffordd Talwrn. If driving too fast towards the top of the hill, the road is not wide enough for two vehicles.

It was agreed to arrange a site visit with FCC Officers and inform Nercwys C.C.
