Minutes of the Meeting held Tuesday 17th February 2026 at Hafan Deg Community Centre, Treuddyn, for 7.00pm

The Chair opened the public meeting and invited the residents to speak.

The residents raised their concerns about the speed of traffic on Ffordd-y-Rhos and what can be done.

The Chair explained that we need data and evidence before we start looking at appropriate measures.

There has been a resident who has made proposals – possibly speed bumps and extra lighting. The resident has been in contact with Mr. L. Shone FCC Highway Officer to discuss the issue.

An Arrive Alive van has been out twice to the area. Another option is the radar logging device, this will be put up and will be the start of the data process, the laying of speed strips will not be used as motorists can see them.

The Chair has received reports of speeding on all roads around the village of Treuddyn.

A flashing 20mph VAS sign would cost approximately £4000

1. Ffordd-yr-Odyn / Mynydd Ddu Junction. Drainage pipe has now collapsed; work will take several days to complete.

2. Blocked culvert at entrance to Green Park, Treuddyn. FCC need to inspect with the Jetter to see which way the culvert goes. If it heads to the right, it will be the responsibility of the residents to put right.

3. Maes Llewelyn on Ffordd y Llan. Work should be going ahead to replace the water mains from No. 1 to No.10

15. Community Councillor's Reports

1. Cae Mynach. The street light was not adopted by Flintshire C.C, and there is no cable running to the column for connection. Residents would need to contact Scottish Power Networks.

2. Ffordd y Gilrhos. A report of a terrible smell along this road.

Cllr. A. Marshall has contacted Hafren Dyfrdwy but they won't come out, NRW have also been contacted but no confirmation has been received that they have been out.

Today the smell has been bad, smelly water with white scum has been running down the road.
The issue is being investigated.

3. Bridleway opposite the Junction of Ffordd y Gilrhos off the A5104.

The bridleway goes through Cae Mawr to Ffrith farm. Cllr. C. Swan stated it has been blocked for many years.

4. Reports of a Christmas tree thrown into a ditch – ditch to be checked if the tree has been removed.

5. Car parked on Ffordd Nercwys no lights are displayed on the car during dark hours. Cars must display parking lights (sidelights) when parked on a road with a speed limit greater than 30mph to remain visible to other road users.
Clerk to contact our PCSO to visit the property where the car is parked.
